1. RULES

- 1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in:
 - a. The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS),
 - i. Appendix T will apply.
 - ii. The last international class rules published on World Sailing will apply when applicable.
 - iii. This NOR.
 - iv. The Sailing Instructions.
- 2. RRS Rule 40.1 will apply at all time while afloat. RRS Rule 40.2 will not apply, so flag "Y" will not be shown.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. The S.I. will be published on the official notice board at least 3 days before the start of the event.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 1. The official notice board will be online on M2S: Manage To Sail.
- 2. {DP} While racing during the whole period of the competition, except in case of emergency, a boat shall not make use of voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data transmission that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The event is open to the Snipe, Cadet and Finn class.
- 2. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the entry form published on M2S from before 15-05-2025 12:00 PM. PLEASE NOTE: "M2S" will be the only way to enter. Late entries will NOT be accepted.
- 3. All Crew members shall be registered by using the entry form on M2S. Failure to comply will automatically grant the O.A. to cancel the registration without any refund.













5. FEES AND PAYMENT:

- 1. The entry fee:
 - a. Single handed dinghy: € 20b. Double handed dinghy: € 30
- 2. Payement
 - a. The payment of the entry fee will be implemented through Molly on M2S before 15-05-2025 12:00 PM.
 - b. Every participant needs to confirm their registration at the race office.
 - c. Claims for travel or accommodation will not be accepted.
- 3. Goody bags
 - a. Upon registering at the Race Office each Participant will receive a goody bag.

- 1. Changes to the schedule will be posted on Manage2Sail before 20:00H on the day before it will take effect.
- 2. When more than one race will be held on the same day, the warning signal of each succeeding race will be made as soon as practicable.
- 3. At the discretion of the race committee and depending on the wind direction, one extra race a day can be sailed.
- 4. No more than 5 races will be sailed during this event.
- 5. No warning signal will be given after 16:00.

10. SAIL NUMBERS, EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. A boat shall register using the National letter(s) and sail number as indicated on her measurement certificate.
- 2. Change of crew or material during the event is subject to approval by the race committee.
- 3. Requests to use a different sail number shall be lodged no later than 30 minutes before that start of the first race.

11. CLOTHING AND EQUIPEMENT:

1. All competitors shall wear a dry- or wet suit at all times while afloat. The water temperature can be very low at this period of the year.

15. SCORING:

- 1. The Low Point scoring system, RRS A4, will apply.
- 2. 3 races shall be completed to constitute an event.
- 3. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding the worst score.

21. DATA PROTECTION:

1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and all the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

22. RISK STATEMENT:

- 1. RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 2. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

23. INSURANCE:

1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a **minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000** or the equivalent per incident.

24. PRIZES:

- 1. Depending on the number of entries there will be prizes as follow:
 - a. 3 up to 6 entries, 1 prize
 - b. 7 up to 10 entries, 2 prizes
 - c. More, 3 prizes

- 1. Food and beverage:

- 2. Parking:
 - a. Cars are **NOT** allowed in the central square.
 - b. Parking for cars and road trailers is on the main road or at the parking space next to the KLYC.
 - c. The hillside **must be kept free** in case of emergency.
 - d. Beach trailers must be left in an orderly way on the site.
